 - 1. President's Report

cleaning up GLO accounts and getting Aaron assigned to everything. Collins has been added to the youth account and Aaron will be working with them on a budget. GLO Retreat for all board members and staff for March 3rd 10 am at GLO.

New Business

- 1. Cleaning Quarterly Cleaning \$133.20. First cleaning was about 3 times that for a first time cleaning.
 - 1. Vote on continuation, Aaron presented how beneficial this has been especially with the increase in use out of the center. No vote is needed to continue paying for this.
