

1. Housing Project

1. Aaron presented, in collaboration effort, to apply for a 3 year grant led by PFLAG to address unhoused LGBTQ+ individuals, specifically TGNC. Right now none of the additional cold shelters allow TGNC individuals. This would be a separate organization that these organizations assist in programming and support. Aaron is asking permission to sign on to the letter of interest in order to apply for the grant. Megan motions to approve The GLO Center signing on to the Keys for Housing grant letter of interest, Holland seconds. All yay, motion passes.
